



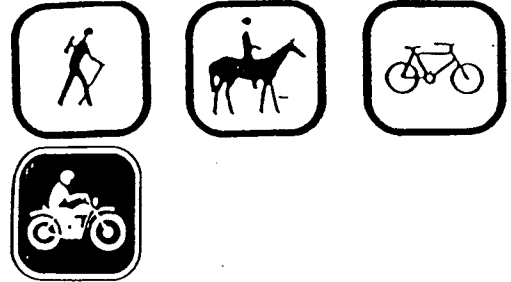

CORRAL SPRINGS TRAIL # 507

Recommended Season: June to November

Length: 3.0 miles Use: Light
 Elevation: 1900' to 4000' Difficulty: More Difficult
 USGS Map: Fish Creek Mtn.



Description:

The trailhead begins at Lookout Springs and continues *down* to Roaring River approximately 3 miles in length. At Roaring River there is a very nice camping area and some good fishing spots. The trail goes through old growth trees.

Trail Access:

Corral Springs Trail # 507 is reached by traveling south from Estacada on Hwy. 224 for 6.4 miles turning left onto the 4610 road just before the road into Promontory State Park. Follow Road 4610 for 12.5 miles until you reach Lookout Springs, approximately 19 miles from Estacada. The trailhead is on the left.

Trail Mileage Log: (Distance from Lookout Springs).

- 0.0 Beginning of trail at Lookout Springs.
- 0.1 Cattle Crossing.
- 0.3 Trail is fairly flat with a 6% slope. The area around the trail has old growth trees and a ground cover of huckleberries and ferns.
- 0.4 Huxley Lake Trail junction.
- 0.5 Trail begins descent at 11% slope.
- 0.7 Cattle guard.
- 1.0 Top of ridge.
- 1.3 Heavy ground vegetation, large fir trees, very pretty area.
- 1.6 Excellent view of Roaring River Canyon. Sparse trees, beargrass and rhodies in the area.
- 1.7 Trail begins a steeper descent of 19% with a series of switchbacks.
- 2.4 Crosses creek.
- 2.8 Trail becomes rocky and slope increases to 40%.
- 3.0 At Roaring River. Very nice camping area.
