GRAVE TRAIL NO. 668



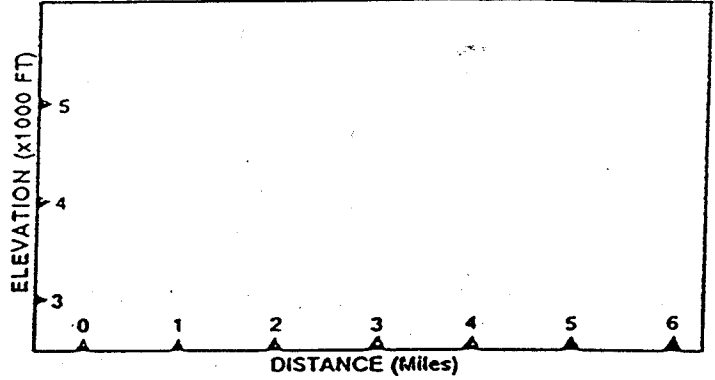
Length: 1 mile (.3 m.)

Difficulty: More Difficult

Use: Moderate

Use Season: Spring, Summer, Fall

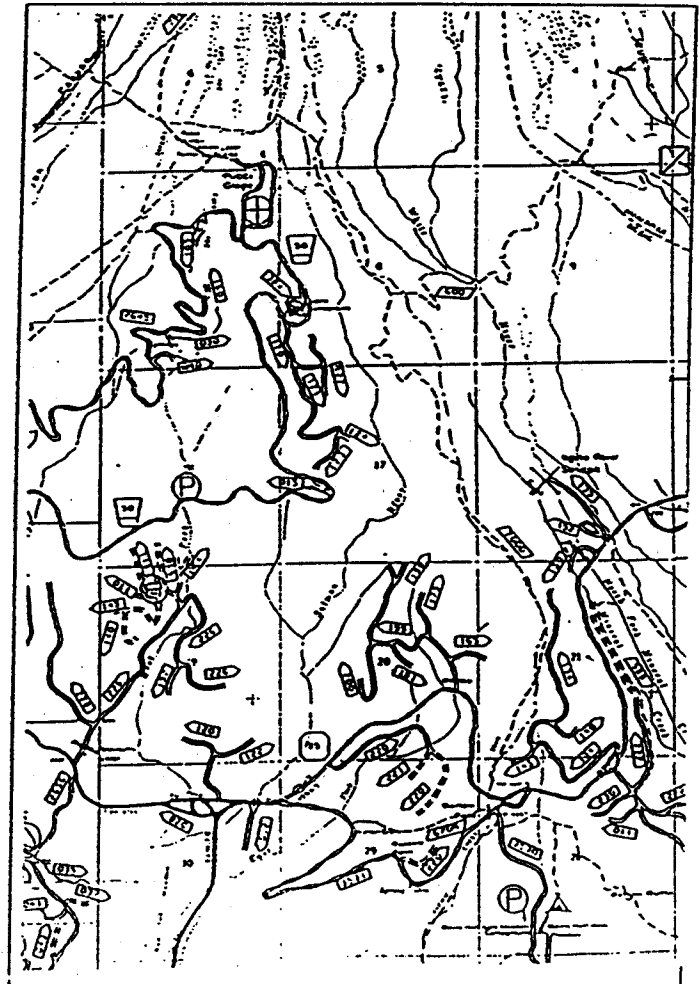
Trailhead(s): 1) 3700 ft. elevation - Pioneer Woman's Grave on forest road 3531. 2) 4150 ft. elevation at Barlow Pass Sno-Park at Jct. of Hwy 35, forest road 3531 and forest road 3530.



Access: 1) Take Hwy. 35 to forest road 3531 and follow 3531 ~ 2 mi. to Pioneer Woman's Grave. Parking is just beyond the grave along 3531 and trail is across road from grave. 2) Take Hwy 35 to Barlow Pass Sno-Park. Parking available, trail leaves sno-park.

Description: Grave is a horse/hiker trail in the summer. From Barlow Pass Sno-Park the trail is downhill at ~ 15-22% grade for about 5/8 mile with some sections level and then becomes gradually level near Pioneer Woman's Grave where the Beaver Marsh Ski Loop leaves the Grave Trail. The route is a portion of the old Barlow Road, is rough and not maintained other than removing blown down logs.
