Trail: Miller Trail #534

Begins: Pacific Crest Trail jct. south of Clackamas Campground

Ends: Trail #528, on southeast arm of Timothy Lake

Access: East on Hwy. 26 to Forest Service road 42, south to jct. of 42 and Pacific Crest Trail. Go south on the Pacific Crest Trail to the Miller Trail #534

Length: 2.5 miles

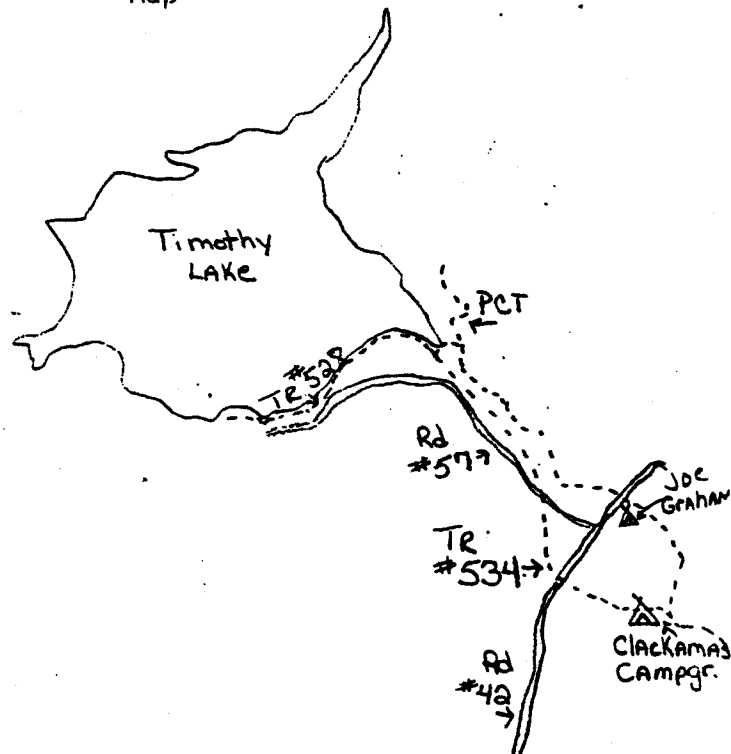

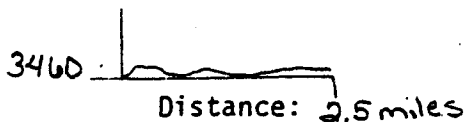
Attractions and Considerations:

This trail is maintained for horse travel through a variety of Forest land. The terrain makes an easy ride. While horses are not allowed in the campgrounds, you do skirt Clackamas and Timothy lakes. The trail then joins the Timothy Lake Trail #528 and Pacific Crest Trail, which makes a loop back to the starting point. In late summer and early fall the forest is vivid with autumn foliage.
