

Mt. Hood Sno*Parks

You must have a valid Sno*Park permit displayed in the windshield of your vehicle if you park in designated winter recreation parking areas (Sno*Parks) between November 1 and April 30. Each of these areas is posted with signs identifying them as a Winter Recreation Area. You will find Sno*Parks in all mountain passes of the state as well as most recognized ski, snowmobile, and snow play areas.

There are three permits available. An annual permit costs \$25.00, a three-day permit costs \$9.00 and a daily permit may be purchased for \$4.00.

The money received from the sale of the Sno*Park permits goes directly to the Oregon Department of Transportation to fund snow removal at the Sno*Parks. The permits are sold at all DMV offices and by permit agents at resorts, sporting goods stores and other retail outlets. Agents are allowed to charge a service fee for each permit they sell.
